1920's

Two young cousins, Edward M. Knabusch and Edwin J. Shoemaker, create a chair that sweeps the world off its feet. The first-ever recliner is born.

1930's

La-Z-Boy encourages everyone to "Recline, Relax, Recuperate" by hosting furniture shows at its Monroe, Michigan store.

1940's

True to the red, white and blue, La-Z-Boy contributes to the war effort by making the most comfortable tank seats and crash pads for our boys in uniform.

1950's
